Additional days required to complete field run is dependent on job duration and scheduling.

Level 1 training should be conducted:

- Prior to equipment being put into operation by first time/untrained users.
- When new staff, operations or equipment are added.
- As a refresher for staff who may require it.



## Level 2 Training

- Level 1 Review
  - All attendees should have Level 1 Certification.
  - Typically performed approximately one year after completion of Level 1.
- Utilizes API Inspection Guidelines
- Introduction to Cat 3 & 4 Inspection
- Technical Development and Assessment

**Duration:** 3 shop/classroom days.

Level 2 training focuses on:

- Training and completion of the annual Category 3 Maintenance as per API RP 8B recommendations.
- Assessing and correcting any deficiencies in current maintenance programs or operating procedures.

\*Additional training is available for complimentary CRT products.
